

Board approved Transcription and Events

The UGB approved the use of AI for transcribing meetings. They updated the calendar, confirming Music Sunday on June 1st and Church School Day on June 15th. For Memorial Day weekend, they decided to hold a remote service on Sunday, May 25th. The Board also discussed creating a new church logo and potentially migrating the website to a new platform. They voted to appoint Stu and Jeneva Burroughs as delegates, along with Rev. Karen, for the upcoming ABCRGR Delegates meeting on May 3rd.

Investing in the Region

The Board discussed investing funds from Sarah Dopp's estate into ABCRGR. They agreed to have the Trustees of Permanent Funds (TPF) research the details, including how the investment would work and what interest, if any, the church would receive. The UGB plans to review this information at their May meeting.

Fellowship Report

Beth will be the co-officiant for communion on May 4th, with Frank and Mark serving. Cindy will be the Lay Reader for the April 27th pancake breakfast and hymn sing, and Mark will emcee the hymn singing part. Mark mentioned that Ray Vega was well received on Easter, with 90 attendees, including some new visitors.

New Staff Position Discussion

The group discussed the job description for the combined role of Coordinator of Education and Outreach Ministries. After discussing it, a motion was made to begin the hiring process using the existing job description. The UGB voted to approve this proposal, with a plan to advertise the position at \$15 per hour, funded equally from the Christian education and missions budgets.

Pastor's Report

Karen reported on the upcoming mission trip, which starts Thursday and runs through Sunday. She thanked the sponsors and noted that Cindy will shop for supplies on Wednesday. Regarding the parking lot issue, Karen shared that the judge denied ICV's petition for summary judgment to dismiss the church's case, which is seen as positive news for the church. However, no timeline for further proceedings has been provided yet.

The group discussed the bell-ringing event commemorating Paul Revere's ride.

Church School News



Classes continue through May. The last day of Sunday classes and the Church School celebration is June 15th. With regret, the CE team has determined that we do not have enough teaching help or program support to hold a Summer Bible Camp this year. We hope there will be opportunities for our church family to get together for fun. The CE team is planning for next year by researching curriculum resources and recruiting teachers and substitutes. Please take a look at the announcement about opportunities to join the teaching team. It's a meaningful ministry for our wonderful kids. The team will be receiving and reviewing scholarship applications. The firm deadline is May 30. Scholarship awards will be announced by June 15th. In addition, the UGB has given the CE and Outreach teams approval to recruit a half-time staff person for a joint position supporting both teams. That would mean the CE team would have 10 hours per week of staff leadership time focused on our Church School and Youth ministry. That will be a big help. This is likely to take a while. SCHOLARSHIPS: The Christian Education Team plans to award modest scholarships again this year. Applicants should have an ongoing relationship with the English speaking and/or Karen Baptist communities, should be enrolled in a post-high school educational program, a college or training program, either full or part time. Applications are available on the table in the Narthex. Applications may be mailed or emailed to applicants who contact the office and request a form. The deadline for applications is May 30th. We also encourage college students to apply for assistance through the Vermont Student Assistance Corporation as soon as possible.

MISSION NEWS



International Ministries has sent an initial grant of \$10,000 in One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) emergency relief to partners who are providing humanitarian relief to the victims of the earthquake that caused widespread devastation in central Myanmar on Friday, March 28th, 2025.

International Ministries (IM) is deeply concerned for the safety and well-being of its global servants, partners in the region, and the communities they serve. All IM personnel have reported they are safe, and we are assessing the needs of our partners in Myanmar and their communities as the situation unfolds.

While the earthquake caused localized damage and loss of life in Thailand, this appeal for emergency relief funds will be focused on the relief and recovery ministry in Myanmar.

IM calls for urgent prayer and support for all those affected by the earthquake. Financial gifts can be through your American Baptist church. Designate to OGHS- Myanmar Relief in the memo of your check. All money will be forwarded to International Ministries. Thus far we have collected \$390.

An update last week from Ann and Bill Clemmer in Goma shared the Easter story of MGH/Harvard Doctors and nurses arriving recently with supportive ventilators for premature infants through their “Heal Africa” program. Easter Monday a premature baby was brought to Heal Africa with challenges breathing. The baby was placed on the “new breathing machine” and the response was immediate. A now healthy baby!
